This is a safe place, a sanctuary of worship and prayer, comfort and justice-seeking for all God's people and all are welcome herejust as you are.

Our church is a safe sanctuary for children.

We are proactive to protect our children with trained staff, enlightened volunteers, and aware congregants.

No concealed weapons of any type are allowed on Tippecanoe Church premises.

Our children are invited to remain in worship with us. The exception is Second and Fourth Sundays of the months during the program year when Heatherlee guides "Children's Wisdom Circle: after Kids' Time.

We ask children be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout our morning together!

During worship, children are welcome to use a book, stuffed animal, or crayons and papers from the bottom shelf of the cart at the back of the sanctuary. We want the sanctuary to be home to them.

When your child (1st grade and under) is restless, when you are, when those around you are... you're/we're probably asking too much of everyone. Please let your child be in the nursery at times like this. Please return borrowed "goodies" to the cart after worship.

Infant through 1st Grade Care

is available all during worship down the stairs in the Cloud Room which is our "nursery."

In the order of worship, please note... the * indicates times to stand as you are able.

We open our hearts and minds to the texts, confronting the radical nature of God's wisdom.

As you enter, please use this time to greet friends, welcome newcomers, and join in the spirit of community.



One: It's Advent. Even within the joy and excitement of this season, we are invited by the true spirit of Christmas to linger long today.... anticipate mystery's coming into the world...invited to enter into the mystery in order to find our way through life...beyond Bethlehem. Life is an open ended journey. For those who believe...life is guided mysteriously toward a star....right through the darkest nights and brightest days...to Bethlehem and beyond. Today, we open to the mystery that longs to guide us. And so, your journey and ours begins again. And we remember.....

♦First Lesson: The Journey Begins

One: In the beginning, God allowed chaos, allowed for troubled dreams and uncertain sounds, and fears in the darkness. From darkness comes light. From a myriad of choices comes the "Way". The Mystery enfolds us!
